QCAR PURPOSE & POLICY

<u>Purpose</u>

A Quarterly Criminal Activity Report (QCAR); to issue revised military justice statistical reporting procedures for the Navy and Marine Corps officers (OJAG) exercising court-martial jurisdiction or exercising nonjudical punishment authority.

Policy

➤ To collect and maintain accurate and timely statistical information reflecting trends in criminal activity and military justice processes. Its necessity helps to measure the efficiency and effectiveness of personnel being disciplined as it relates to the Department of the Navy.
